Bully B. E. A. N. S Bullies Everywhere Are Now Stopped, Julia Cook, Apr 30, 2009, , 32 pages. Winston, the smartest boy in school, finds himself constantly bullied by Bobbette, and it's up to the other members of his class to try and put a stop to it..
