This NEW RELEASE by Author Ronan Murray uncovers many of the mysteries about the Drombeg Stone Circle in West Cork, Ireland. In this unique hard cover, large format book, with laminated covers, full of photos and illustrations, with accurately laid out site plans (based on the 1959 Archaeological Excavations of Edward Fahy), you will find the original ideas and construction methods for this Bronze Age Triad of Stone Circles which include the sites of Bohonagh and Reenascreena over 8 Kilometres (5 Miles) away laid out in the form of an Equilateral Triangle, aligned to the Cycle of the Sun at the Equinox, and oriented to the North Star.

The cultural significance of this book is profound in that the concepts put forward show the Bronze Age Irish of 1,000 BC to have an amazing facility with numbers, geometry, and land surveying. There is a knowledge displayed at Drombeg about the cycles of the sun at the equinox that also shows the influence of the Babylonian numeral system, geometry, and Babylonian mathematics used in the Mesopotamian region dating as far back as 3,000 BC.

The author through seven years of on-site research puts forward an amazing system of Perfect Numbers, including using a Golden Ratio, that these sun-worshippers over 3,000 years ago, (c.1100 BC), used to create a Sacred Geometry to join the life-giving Elements of Sunlight and Water from the God of the Sky, to the Goddess of the Earth.

The Way of Dreams is a journey that begins with a Challenge to get us out of our comfort zone where beyond our fear lives the Inspiration to live our Dreams. With the Light of Inspiration in hand we journey down the mountain into the inevitable valley of Obstacles where we learn to Accept Failure and move past Regret. In that place of Failure and Regret, when all else is stripped away, it is there that we find that one thing brightly shining. It is our gift, our one unique gift that each of us has deep within us; something quite special that can change the world. With that purpose to guide us we Return again to the journey that we started so long ago upon the mountain, and the world below will be a better place for what we have found.

Tapestry is a seven book collection in a hand-crafted, hand-bound, hardcover book and is in its

essence a Volume of Completed Works. Tapestry includes four new works entitled the Gravity of Conscience (an entreaty of poems for beauty and the natural world); Ancient Memories of Ireland (poems of myth and legend); The Ritual (saving Arnhem Land about the Australian Aborigines); and a section called Rogues and Other Poems.

This collection is varied in its genre and will give you many happy hours of exploring the depths of the human condition, the deep past of ancient Ireland, the mysterious culture of the Aborigines, and the flight of dreams and aspirations. The book is hand crafted by Brownes Bookbinders and is a hardcover, bound in linen cloth, with Gold Leaf Emboss, and a decorative headband. Truly a book that will stand the test of time.

The Celt & The Crone Audio Book is a Poetry Play performed and narrated by the Author on CD. The Celt & The Crone Audio Book comes complete with Audio CD including an Illustrated Booklet of the play so you can follow along. The original pen & ink illustrations were drawn by West Cork Artist Eleanor Murray of Firebird Arts.

The Celt & The Crone paperback is an illustrated book of a poetry play. It is a story about a mysterious encounter with the Goddess Brigid in Ireland's ancient past when an arrogant Celtic Warrior wounded in battle finds his way to her cottage in the woods. As in the Audio Book CD the pen & Ink Illustrations were provided by West Cork Artist Eleanor Murray of Firebird Arts.

In Search of the Ancient is a Pilgrim's Journal of true experiences in poems and short stories about a six month backpacking journey to explore and discover the mysteries of Ancient Ireland found in the many megalithic stone circles, cairns, and dolmens across the country. As in all journeys what we expect and what we find are often times not exactly what we had intended and this journey had a mind of its own. It lead me for the next ten years into the most difficult and exciting years a person searching for Ireland's ancient past could hope for.
