This book is about how to raise children that are an ongoing source of delight, children that cheerfully obey when asked to do something, children that joyfully walk with God, children that grow into adulthood all the while becoming good, honest companions. It's a book that asks you to think through how you're raising your children: what you expect and how you're going about it. It's about diligent love, great affection and houses filled with joy and peace. Finally, it's a book about God's faithful provision and the immutable promises He holds out to you.

I must be clear on something: godly, joyful, obedient, and honoring children are what God intends. Further, they're what He's provided for; not in a sparing, stingy sort of way, but in an unwavering and bountiful way. Children like that are neither utopian nor abnormal. They can be raised in Moscow, Idaho and they can be raised in Manhattan or Los Angeles. They are what He has in mind when He gives them to us and then charges us to "train them up in the way they should go."

Have you ever thought this might not be true? If you have, I want to reassure you and put to rest some common misconceptions. For instance, the idea that teenagers are somehow fated to be rebellious and drift away from their parents, or that the two's will necessarily be terrible, or that siblings are destined to bicker and quarrel. There's not a word of truth in these. In all three instances God intends the opposite to be true. He not only intends it, He provides for it. And He can bring it about in your home.

I grew up in Southern California where I was educated by the nuns first, then by the Jesuits; got caught up in the seventies; moved to Idaho to study Forestry at the University in Moscow; met a girl, got saved, got married, stumbled into the CPA profession, raised four children, started Logos School with a couple of friends, helped plant and co-pastor a few churches, and learned to fly fish.

I have known Larry and Connie since very early in their Christian lives. You might say that I have grown up with their kids, even though I am old enough to be their grandfather. I hold all of them as close friends in Christ and in very high regard. I read this little book a year ago. I am reading it again now. I was impressed then and am more impressed now. I don't know a book like it. Although it is instruction about raising children, God is the real subject of this book. It is clear, concise, not trite, wise and tender. It is not a book of methods as in whether you spank with a spoon, ping-pong paddle, or cedar shingle. It is a book of attitudes and principles and it is biblical. I am already thinking of people, young and old to whom I can give it.

I've got a neat little book here in my hand... And the title is The Things You'll See, the sub title, Notes To My Children On How They Were Raised. Each chapter is about a page or page and a half. This book is very easy to read. It's full of extremely practical stuff. Example, get clear on what kind of people you want them to be. That's an early chapter in it. And another one is 'There is a way that seems right to a man', that's taken from the book of proverbs. Anyway, it's a nice little book, a nice give away book to people who are attempting to rear their children;
