This note provides information on the design of a maternity department consisting of: a) entrance; b) an antenatal/postnatal clinic suite including ultrasound facilities; c) day assessment facilities including early pregnancy care; d) in-patient accommodation including birthing facilities, an obstetric operating theatre suite, and provision for high dependency care; e) a neonatal unit. The scedule of accommodation is based on a workload of 2,500 births per annum..
